Except for the period of the 1880 and 1888 International Exhibitions, the management of the Exhibition Building has been in the hands of the Exhibition Trustees. This continuity of history will cease when the Museum of Victoria takes over the management of the Great Hall as part of the relocation of the museum to the Exhibition Reserve and Carlton Gardens.

Nina Stanton, consultant to the Exhibition Trustees since 1988, will tell the fascinating history of the Royal Exhibition Building as she foreshadows what in years to come will be recognized as the legacy of the Exhibition Trustees - the successful financial management of the building enabling the completion of a ten million dollar restoration programme, the establishment of an historical collection and archive and the publication of the history of the building in book form.
