Fitzroy - a Descriptive Bibliography by Carole Woods.

Carole Woods is a very experienced bibliographer and the author of Beechworth - a Titan's Field (1985)

Mr. Ian McLaren is Honorary Bibliographer at Melbourne University's Baillieu Library and a noted author of bibliographies for Australian local history and biography. He was M.L.A. in the Victorian Parliament for 16 years and a Deputy Speaker.

The Bibliography has been funded by the E.M.E. Cutten Trust. It will be on sale for \$5.00 at the launching and subsequently can be purchased at the Napier Street Library.
