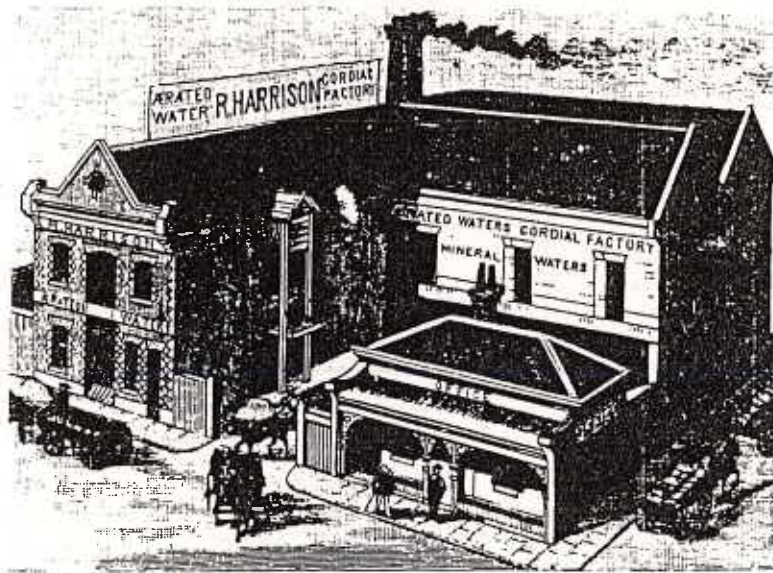




JULY ACTIVITY

"FITZROY'S FACTORIES"

A walk led by GARY VINES.
Meet on the steps of the Fitzroy Town Hall
at 2 p.m. Sunday 25 July 1993

The walk will look at some of the more unusual factories of Fitzroy including the famous Mac.Robertson's Confectionery Works and the not-so-famous, such as Lewis and Whitty's Blacking factory, the "Odourbane" Works and Ferguson's Mantle Factory as well as the characteristic boot and shoe and clothing factories. On the way we will see how the surviving factory buildings in the suburb have been re-used and recycled to provide offices, homes and new factories with a unique character. Brief historical notes will be available after the walk.

GARY VINES is an historian and industrial archaeologist from Melbourne's Living Museum of the West, a community museum devoted to recording, preserving and presenting the unique history, culture and environment of Melbourne's western region and working people in general.
